## The Month of MUHARRAM

Muharram heralds the beginning of the Islamic Calendar. It is one of the four sanctified months. The 10th day of Muharram is the most sacred among all its days. The day is named 'Ashura'.

Ibn Abbas رضي الله عنه narrated that the Rasulallah ﷺ came to Madinah and found the Jews fasting on the day of Áshura. (Rasulallah ﷺ inquired of them, "What is (the significance of) this day on which you fast?" They replied, "This is a great day. On this day Allah saved Moosa and his people and drowned Fir'oun and his nation. Thus Moosa ﷺ fasted on this day as a token of thanksgiving, therefore we too fast on this day. The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said, "We are more worthy of Moosa ﷺ and nearer to him than you." Thereafter, Rasulallah ﷺ fasted on this day and instructed (his companions) that a fast be kept on this day. (Muslim)

Messenger of Allah ﷺ said: He who fasts on the day of Arafah (9th Zul Hiijah), his fast will be a compensation for the sins of two years and the one that keeps a fast in the month of Muharrarm will receive the reward of thirty fasts for each fast. (Tabrdni, At-targheeb)

The Prophet ﷺ said: "Observe the fast of Ashura and oppose the yahood. Fast a day before it or a day after." (Bayhaqi)

Ibn Masóod رضي الله عنه reported that Rasulallah ﷺ said, 'He who will be generous on his family on the Day of Áashura, Allah will be generous to him throughout the year.'

Rasulallah ﷺ said: "The best of fasts besides the month of Ramadaan is the fast of Allah's Month, Muharram and the best of salaah besides the fardh (compulsory) salaah is Tahajjud salaah (performed after midnight before dawn). (Muslim)

Abu Bakr رضي الله عنه reported that Rasulallah ﷺ said: "Time has come back to its original state which it had when Allah created the Heavens and the Earth; the year is twelve months, four of which are sacred. Three of them are in succession: Dhul-Qa`da, Dhul-Hijja and Al-Muharram, and (the fourth is) Rajab"
