## Month of Sha'baan

Narrated Hazrat Anas رضي الله عنه: Upon the arrival of Rajab, the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم used to pray, "O Allah! Bless us abundantly in Rajab, & Sha'baan, & deliver us safely to Ramadhaan."

Narrated by Hazrat Aisha رضي الله عنها: "I never saw Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم, fasting in a month so profusely as he did in the month of Sha'ban. He used to fast in that month leaving only a few days, rather, he used to fast almost the whole of the month."

Anas رضي الله عنه, reported that Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم, was asked, "Which fast is the most meritorious after the fasts of Ramadan?" He replied, "Fasts of Sha'ban in honor of Ramadan."

Usama ibn Zaid رضي الله عنه, reports that he asked Prophet Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم: "Messenger of Allah, I have seen you fasting in the month of Sha'ban so frequently that I have never seen you fasting in any other month." Prophet Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم, replied: "That (Sha'ban) is a month between Rajab and Ramadan which is neglected by many people. And it is a month in which an account of the deeds (of human beings) is presented before the Lord of the universe, so, I wish that

## ARE WE PREPARING FOR RAMADHAAN?

The Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم would anticipate Ramadhaan two months in advance. The companions report that the noble Master صلى الله عليه وسلم would beseech Allah Ta'ala in the following manner, "O Allah, bless us in Rajab and Sha'baan and allow us to remain alive until the month of Ramadhan."

Hadhrat Aisha رضي الله عنها reports that when Ramadaan arrived, the color of Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم face used to change. He used to increase Salaat, become even more humble in his Du'as and have even more fear for Allah. He hardly ever lay down in bed until Ramadaan came to an end. (Durr-e-Manthoor).

During Ramadhan, 70,000 angels daily make Dua of forgiveness on behalf of the fasting person, from the time of Subah Salat until sunset. (Hadith).

Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم said: "Saum (fasting) and the Qur'an will intercede on behalf of the servant (of Allah). Saum will say 'My Rabb! I forbade him from sleep at night and desires during the day, therefore, accept my intercession on his behalf.' The Qur'an will say: 'I forbade him from sleep at night, therefore accept my intercession on his behalf.' Thus, their intercession will be accepted".

Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم said: Every action of the son of Adam is for him except fasting, for that is solely for Me. I give the reward for it. Fasting is a shield. If one is fasting, he should not use foul language, or raise his voice, or behave foolishly. If someone reviles him or fights with him, he should say, I am fasting, twice. By the One in whose hand is the soul of Muhammad, the breath of a person who is fasting is better in the sight of Allah, on the day of resurrection, than the smell of musk. The one who is fasting feels happy at two occasions: when he breaks his fast, he is happy with it, and when he meets his Lord [in the day of judgement] he will be happy too. (Muslim & Abu Daud)
