Dhul Hijjah & Sacrifice

The days of Sacrifice begin from the 10th after Eid salaat up to sunset of the 12th Zil-Hijjah. Sacrifice is Wajib (obligatory) on a person on whom Sadqe-e-Fitr is wajib.

Hazrat Ibn Abbas رضي الله عنه relates that Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم said, "On no other days are good deeds more liked by Allah than on these days, the first ten days of Dhul Hijjah." The Sahaabah asked, "O Rasulullah, not even Jihaad in the way of Allah Ta'ala?" Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم replied, "Not even Jihaad in the way of Allah Ta'ala, except for that person who goes out to fight with his life and wealth and does not return with anything." (Bukhari)

It is reported from Abu Huraira رضي الله عنه that Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم said, "On no days is the worship of Allah Ta'ala more loved than in the first 10 days of Dhul Hijjah. The fast of each of these days is equal to the fast of a whole year, and the Ibaadat of each of these nights is equal to the Ibaadat of Laila-tul-Qadr." (Tirmizi & Ibn Majah)

It is related by Ibn Abbas رضي الله عنه that Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم said, 'No days are as weighty with Allah and so liked by Him for good deeds than the first 10 days of Dhul Hijjah. So in these days increasingly read TASBEEH (Subhanallah) TAHLEEL (La ilaha illallah), TAHMEED (Alhamdulillah) and TAKBEER (Allahu Akbar)." (Tabraani)

It is related that Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم said, "Whomever stays awake and makes Ibaadat on the nights of Eid-UI-Fitr and Eid-UI-Adha, his heart will not die on the day when all hearts will be dead." (Targheeb)

Hazrat Zaid ibn Arqam رضي الله عنه related that the companions of Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم asked, "O Rasulullah, what is sacrifice?" He replied, "It is the Sunnah of your father Ibraheem". They asked again, "What benefit do we get from it?" he answered, "A reward for every hair of the sacrificed animal." And what reward is there for animals with wool?" they asked. "A reward," he said, 'for every fiber of the wool."

Rasulullah صلى الله عليه وسلم has said, "The person who sacrifices with a willing heart and with the niyyat of reward, then on the Day of Judgment that sacrifice will shield him from the fires of hell."
