## Repel poverty / Increase Wealth

• **Dhikr and Dua** - "I (Nuh عليه السلام) said (to his people): Ask forgiveness from your Lord; Verily, He is Oft-Forgiving. He will send rain to you in abundance. And give you increase in wealth and children, and bestow on you gardens and bestow on you rivers." (71:10-12) Hadith narrated in Majma'ul Awsat, 'Whoever is suffering from lack of sustenance should recite Laa howla wa laa quwwata illa billaa hil alliyil azeem

• **Repentance** - Rasulallah صلى الله عليه وسلم said, 'Whoever adopts istighfaar, Allah will grant him salvation from every type of problem and calamity.' (Abu Dawud)

• **Recitation of Qur'an** - Narrated Anas رضي الله عنه: 'Surah Waqi-ah is a chapter of wealth. Read it yourself and teach it to your children.' (Ibn Mardawayah).  
 Narrated Abdullah ibn Mas'ud رضي الله عنه: 'Whoever recites Surah Ikhlās when entering the house, it will distance poverty from the inhabitants of the house and the neighbours.' (Tabrani)

• **Durud** - Narrated Ubay رضي الله عنه, 'How will that be if I only recited salawaat, instead of all other devotions and du'a?' He replied, 'If you do so, Allah will take responsibility for all your needs of this world' (Musnad Ahmad)

• **Washing the hands** - Narrated Anas رضي الله عنه, 'Whoever desires his sustenance to be increased by Allah, should regularly wash his hands before and after partaking meals.' (Ibn Majah)

• **Salaah** - "And enjoin Salaah upon your family, and be patient in offering it. We ask not of you a provision, We provide for you. And the good end (i.e. Paradise) is for the pious." (20:132). Narrated Thabit رضي الله عنه that whenever the family of Rasulallah صلى الله عليه وسلم faced the difficulties of poverty, he would call out to them, 'Perform Salaah, Perform Salaah.' (Kitaab Az-Zuhd)

• **Family ties** - Narrated Abu Hurairah رضي الله عنه, 'Whoever desires to have an increase in his sustenance and in his age, should maintain family ties.' (Bukhari)

• **Piety** - Narrated Abu Dar رضي الله عنه, once Rasulallah صلى الله عليه وسلم recited the verse, 'And He will provide him from (sources) he never could imagine. And whosoever puts his trust in Allah, then He will suffice him. Verily, Allah will accomplish his purpose.' (65:3) And then he said, 'Abu Dhar, if all the people had to practice on this verse, it would suffice for them.'
