Are you ready for HAJ yet???

"Pilgrimage to the House (of Allah) is a duty man owes to Allah, upon those who can afford the journey."

Rasulullah ﷺ said: "He who intends to perform (the obligatory) Haj should hasten in performing it" (Abu Dawood).

Hazrat Abu Moosa ﷺ reports that Rasullullah ﷺ said: "The Hajji shall intercede on behalf of four hundred families or he said four hundred people from his family, and verily does he return from Hajj (sinless) as on the day his mother gave birth to him."

It is related by Ali ؓ that Rasullullah ﷺ said: "Anyone whom Allah Ta'ala has given enough to perform the Haj, and he, also, has a conveyance which can take him to House of Allah Ta'ala, if he still fails to do so then it does not matter whether he dies a Jew or a Christian, and it is so because Allah Ta'ala has said: Pilgrimage to the House (of Allah Ta'ala) is a duty men owe to Allah Ta'ala - those who can afford the journey." Continuous Hajj and Umrah prevents a Muslim from leaving this life with a bad ending, and keeps away poverty."

Hazrat Umar ؓ used to say: "One of the signs of generosity of a person is the fact, that provisions for the (Haj) journey are of the best quality."

Hazrat Jaabir ؓ reports that Rasullullah ﷺ said: "A Hajji never becomes poor and destitute."

Hazrat Ibn Umar ؓ report that Rasullullah ﷺ said: "When you meet a Hajji (on his way home) then greet him, shake hands with him and ask him to beg forgiveness of Allah on your behalf before he enters his home, for his prayer for forgiveness is accepted since he is forgiven by Allah for his sins."
